### *Exploring Alternative Realities*

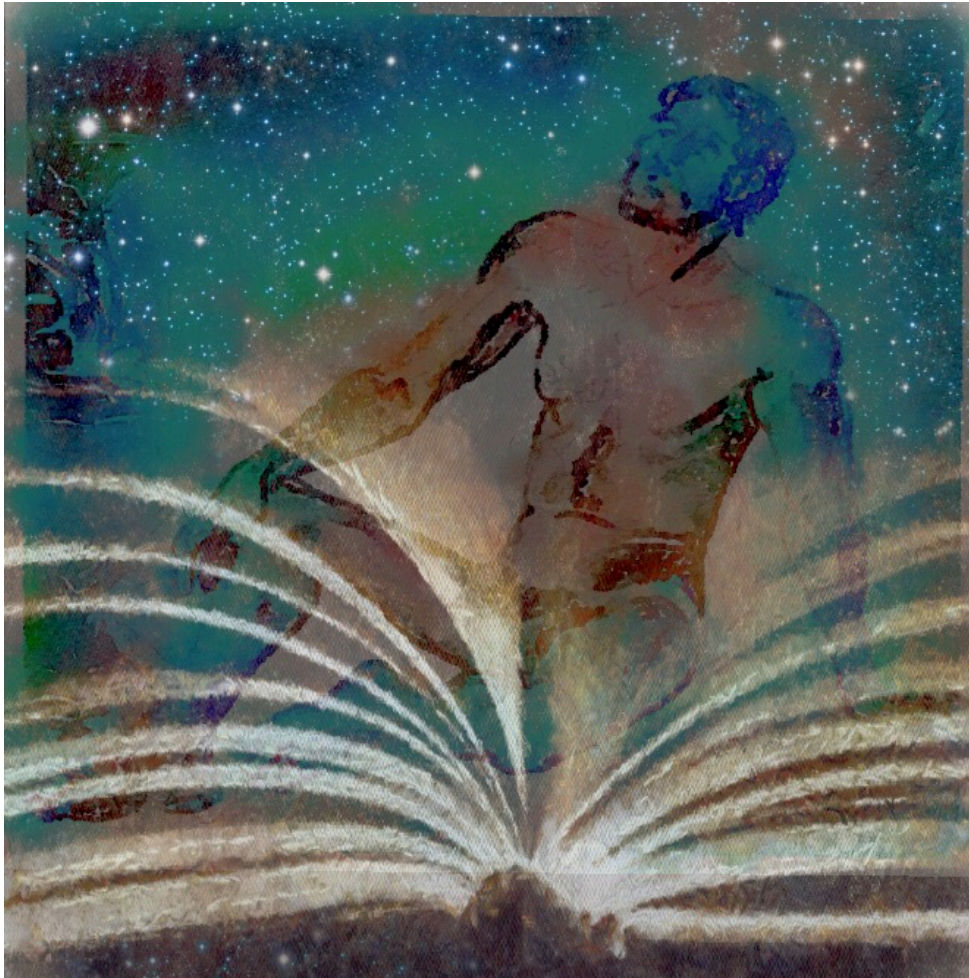
Beyond the clouds
