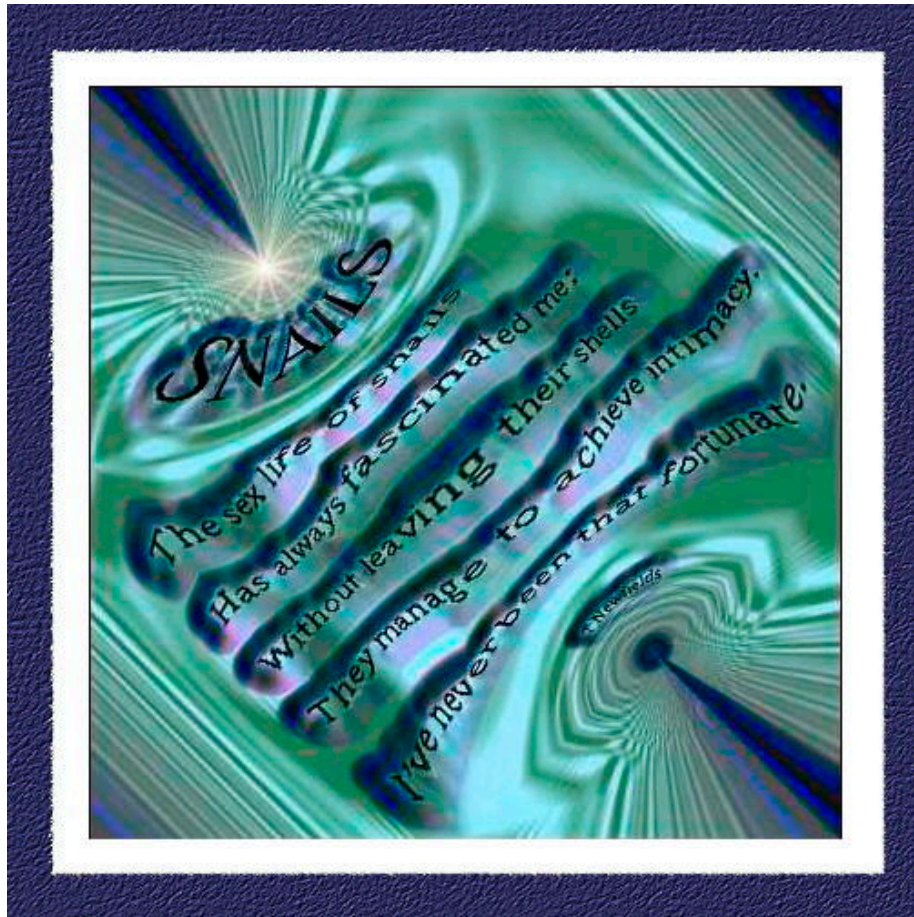


SNAILS: *Exploring the Sexuality of Gastropods*
