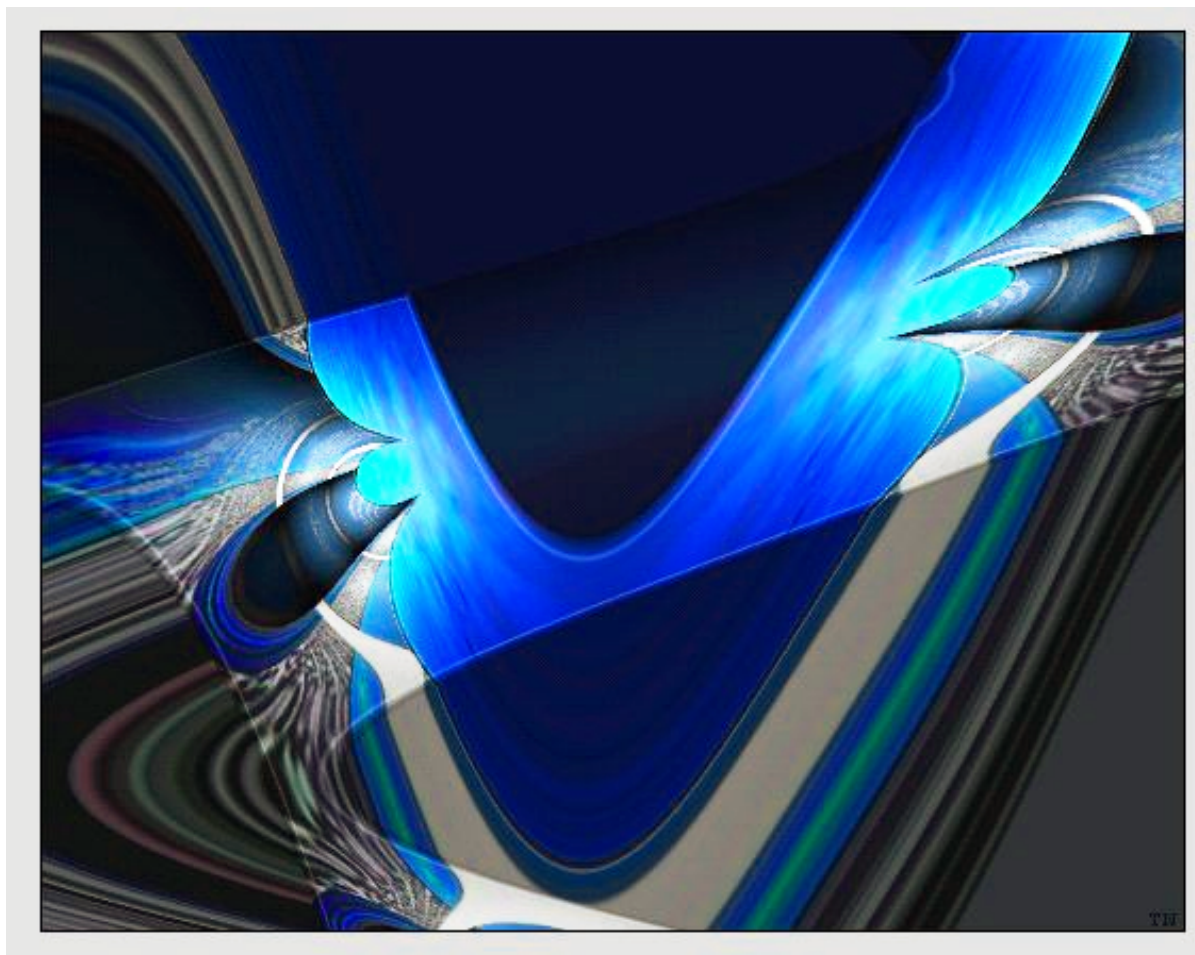


Lit-A-Rupture: A Post Literary Construction by T Newfields
