why not treasure more shades?

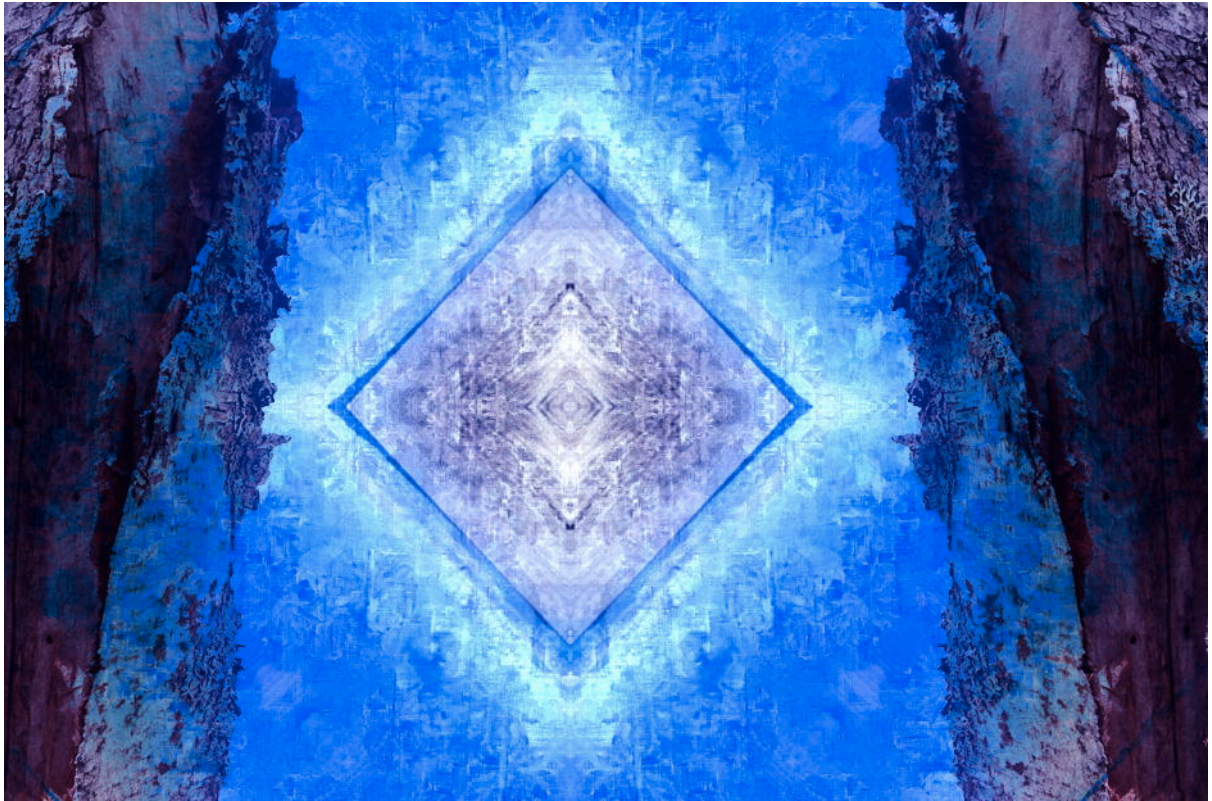
Open the waters ah imagination
