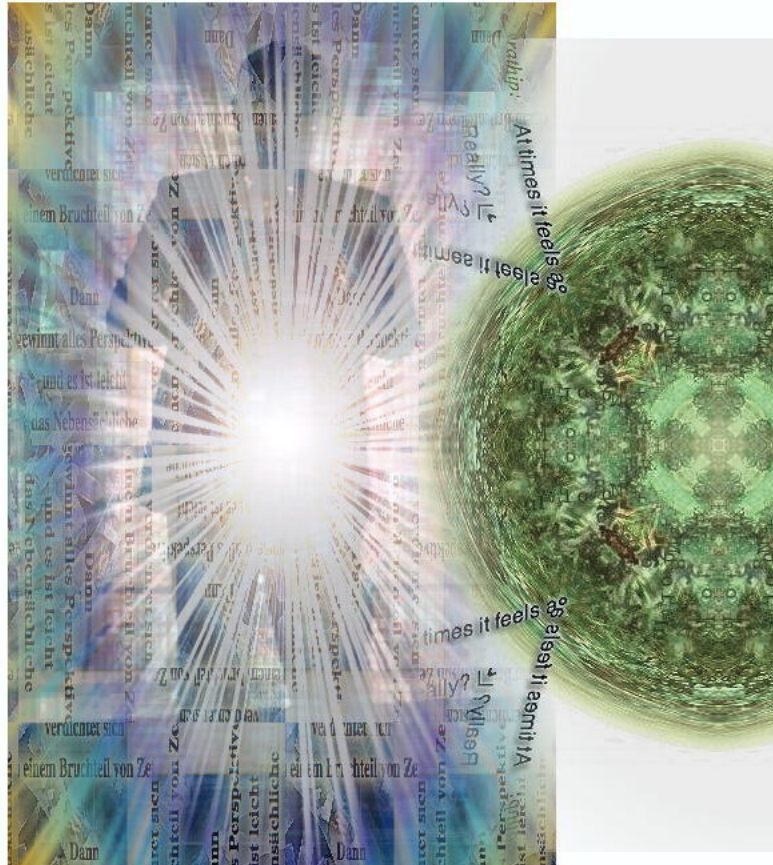


HEART OF SPRING:
